Description

- The Colgan High School Center for the Fine and Performing Arts (CFPA) Outstanding Senior Scholarship Program provides financial assistance to graduating seniors enrolling in an accredited undergraduate program directly related to the fine, performing or related arts. It is anticipated that the awardee will major or minor in said arts.
- Recipients will be selected based on demonstrated service to the CFPA program, academics, volunteerism, extra-curricular activities, letters of recommendation, and short responses to prompts.
- The scholarships, each with a value of \$1000, will be awarded at Senior Awards in May 2022.

Eligibility Criteria for Current Seniors Who Are

- Members, in good standing, of the CFPA Program at Charles J. Colgan Senior High School;
- Anticipating completion of high school diploma at the time of application;
- Carrying a minimum 3.0 GPA at the time of application;
- Applying to and/or have been accepted and enrolling in an accredited undergraduate program directly related to the fine, performing or related arts in the Fall 2022.



Application Materials

To be Submitted:

1. A **resume** detailing education, CFPA involvement, extra-curricular activities and achievements/accolades (see Slide 6). [Google Form](#)
2. Your current **Grade Point Average (GPA)**.
3. Two (2) **Letters of Recommendation**; one from a CFPA instructor and one from a non-CFPA instructor (see Slide 7). [Google Form](#)
4. Respond to any two (2) of the following **essay prompts** (250 word limit each).

Essay Prompts:

- A. The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
- B. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
- C. Tell a story from your life, describing an experience that either demonstrates your character or helped to shape it.
- D. Describe a time when you made a meaningful contribution to others in which the greater good was your focus. Discuss the challenges and rewards of making your contribution.
- E. Submit an essay on a topic of your choice.

Two (2) Letters of Recommendation

1. Submit a letter of recommendation from a **CFPA instructor** who knows you well enough to speak to your talent and CFPA involvement (250 word limit).
2. Submit a second letter of recommendation from a **non-CFPA instructor**, employer, coach, or community member who knows you well enough to speak to your talent, character, accomplishments, strengths and/or community involvement (250 word limit).
