1. Prepare a typed resume with your full name and email contact information identifying your Education Program and Fine or Performing Arts Concentration(s).
  - a. Detail your involvement in the following:
    - i. **CFPA Service:** Detailed description of all your different types of involvement in the CFPA program.
    - ii. **Volunteer Work:** Include your volunteer work, both within school, as well in the community.
    - iii. **Extra-curricular activities:** Roles, leadership, responsibilities, and the length of time you were involved in each.
    - iv. **Achievements/accolades:** Provide any details that would give us insight of your accomplishments.
2. Submit your high school transcripts showing your overall GPA (must be a 3.0 or above). An unofficial transcript produced from the PWCS website will suffice. Contact your counselor if you need assistance.
3. Attach your responses to the two following prompts: (250 word limit for each prompt) -
  - a. Tell us how you continued to prosper and contribute to the CFPA program as well as your community while dealing with the challenges of COVID-19?
  - b. What are your long-term career goals and how did the CFPA program prepare or assist you in choosing these goals?
4. Submit one letter of recommendation from a NON-CFPA instructor, employer, coach, or community member who knows you well enough to speak to your accomplishments, strengths, and perseverance. Letters must be emailed by the writer directly to:
